

# BerryPatch Quilt and Art Expo Registration Information (Oct. 13, 2007)

**DEADLINE:** Quilts must be mailed or delivered to BerryPatch Preservation for Quilting & Visual Arts LLC between the dates of Sept. 24 and Oct. 10, 2007, at P. O. Box 189, or 154 W. Pine St. Ponchatoula, LA, 70454. No quilts will be accepted after Oct. 10.

1. A registration form is required for each quilt. The form is used as the **QUILT TAG** for each quilt.
2. ALL quilts must have an information label on back of quilt. (Owner, maker, date made, etc.)
3. All quilts must remain on display for the duration of the show.
4. Quilts may be photographed by show attendees, the media and BerryPatch Preservation, submission constitutes permission by the quilter/owner to do so.
5. Enclose a prepaid address label to have your quilt returned by mail.
6. If delivering please deliver Monday thru Friday, 9:00A.M. to 4:00 P.M., or by appointment, call 985-386-7600
7. Antique and delicate quilts will be displayed inside The Community Center on a first come first serve basis. All other quilts will be displayed on the buildings of Ponchatoula. We will give your quilts the loving care they deserve!
8. Quilts may be picked up at The Community Center (300 North 5<sup>th</sup> Street) from 4:30 to 5:00 P.M. on Oct 13, 2007, with proper identification. (Bottom portion of this form).
